Implemented Activities

Working in conjunction with academic and student representatives from the Universities of East Anglia, Warwick, Birmingham and Keele, the University of Cambridge led a consortium in the development of eLearning videos and a national database.

INSPIRE: Interactive National Student Portal of Information on Research Expertise:

- This is a national web-based resource to support student engagement with research in all UK Medical/Dental Schools and to foster greater collaboration between Schools.
- The 'Medidem' database (<u>www.medidem.ac.uk</u>) is a national database of Research Supervisors and projects that facilitates greater student access to research opportunities.
- Six videos have been completed with students having an active part in their creation by directing the choice of topics covered and their contents.

INSPIRE is coordinated by the Academy of Medical Sciences and supported by the Wellcome Trust. INSPIRE activities are designed and delivered locally by individual medical schools.
