Implemented Activities

This particular application came from not just one particular dental school, but rather on behalf of dentistry as a whole. The aim of the project was to inspire more students, especially female students, to pursue academic careers in dentistry. The activities carried out included:

A One Day Conference:

- A Conference targeted at undergraduate dental students with the aim of stimulating interest in an academic career was held at King's College Dental Institute in 2015. It involved talks and workshops aimed at inspiring dental students to enter an academic career and to encourage more females to enter dental academia.

Various Events around the UK:

- Following this main event, the INSPIRE research champions have gone on to organise their own events which are taking place at various schools around the UK using the grant budget to do so.
