- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Connected to both local and national networks
- Willingness to embrace new ideas and approaches, share ideas and learn from others
- Excellent communication skills, experienced and regular user of modern digital communication.

Role overview

At present the remit of the champions is fairly open so that Fellows have flexibility to respond to the needs of their region. Suggested activities might include:

- Hosting regional engagement events such as discussion dinners, careers meetings, scientific lectures and social events.
- Identifying grass roots issues, gathering intelligence from local initiatives and horizon scanning future challenges.
- Supporting diversity of candidate nominations and celebrating the election of new Fellows in that region.
- Providing guidance on the Fellowship election process
- Cascading calls for information or evidence from the Academy's working groups or committees.
- Disseminating Academy outputs and reports, funding calls and nominations for schemes.
- Providing input into the Academy's broader strategy and operations from a regional perspective.

Champions will be expected to deliver some, not all, of these activities and will be free to suggest alternatives. Champions are asked to report on impacts to the Academy and share experiences with other champions via one meeting a year (February) and via periodic e-mails or teleconferences.

Champions serve for three years. The positions in the areas advertised will be effective Dec 2019–Dec 2022.
