Voting is now open: election of Council members for 2026

This year's election will fill two vacancies on Council created when Professor Dame Ijeoma Uchegbu and Professor Kathryn Maitland step down in December. On behalf of the Academy I extend my thanks to both of them for their exceptional and selfless service.

We are once again collaborating with Civica Election Services to deliver this year's election. I urge Fellows to take advantage of this accessible opportunity to participate in an important Academy governance process. The Academy Council should be representative of the Fellowship itself and it is vital that Fellows express their preferences for the composition of our governing body.

The ballot will close at 17:00 on Thursday 6 November and the results of this year's election will be announced at the Academy's Annual Fellows' Meeting on 3 December 2025 - after which they will appear on the Academy website.

Do please take this opportunity to express your views. We are hoping to match or improve on last year's record turnout rate of 42%.
